### PREPARATION POLICY

As a member of the Australian Deaflympic Team ("ADT"), you must meet the following requirements in regard to your preparation to be selected as an ADT member and once selected, prior and during the Games. Throughout this policy, the ADT will be interchangeable with "Deaf Sports Australia" ("DSA"), "International Deaflympic Committee" ("IDC") and "Melbourne 2005 Deaflympic Games Ltd" ("M2005").

1. PREPARATION OBLIGATIONS - You agree to work with your Section Management to plan a written coaching, training and competition program for yourself and undertake and maintain a training (including physical fitness) program under their guidance. This may also include the submission of regular reports.
2. RESTRICTIONS TO PREPARATION - You will disclose to your Section Management any matter, that may at any time, affect your full and proper participation in the activities of the Section or adversely affect your training and competition including, without limitation, any illness or injury, as soon as you become aware of it.
